## ACCEPTABLE DOCUMENTATION --FOR WHAT?

Wisconsin Drivers License\*
Wisconsin State ID\*
Passport\*
Military ID\*

 May be used if expired after the date of the last general election (11/2/10)

Certificate of Naturalization issued less than 2 years prior to the election

Receipt for Drivers License issued less than 60 days prior to the election

ID issued by a federally recognized Indian Tribe in WI

College or university student ID that includes

- Date of Issuance
- Signature of Student
- Expiration date no later than 2 years after issuance
- Accompanied with proof of enrollment

REGISTRATION

Must provide number of WI

**Drivers License or State ID if** 

**ELECTION DAY** 

vou have one

Residency—One of the following required

WI Drivers License or State ID with current address

Any ID card or license issued by a WI government agency

Lease, property tax bill for current year

Utility bill sent within last 90 days

Affidavit on public or private social service agency letterhead

Bank statement

Pay stub

One in each category is required: **Legal presence** 

**OBTAINING A** 

STATE ID

- Certified birth certificate
- Certificate of citizenship
- Valid passport
- TSA workers ID

**Identity** 

- Social Security Card
- Marriage certificate
- Divorce certificate
- Out of state drivers license or state ID
- TSA workers ID
- Military discharge papers
- Military dependent card
- Legal Guardian ID card

WI Residency

- Pay Stub
- Mortgage or Lease documents
- Utility bill
- Employee Photo ID
- Bank Statement
- Certified School Record
- Government issued correspondence

For a WI birth certificate, just fill out a form and mail in.

- No documents needed.
- Cost is \$20.

**OBTAINING A** 

**BIRTH CERTIFICATE** 

• Time to obtain is two weeks.

In person, you must show valid state-issued ID with current address

Requirements vary in other states. Refer to the Department of Vital Records in that state. 34 states require a copy of your state-issued photo ID or passport. Time to receive birth certificates—up to 6 months. Costs vary.
