ACCEPTABLE DOCUMENTATION --FOR WHAT?

VOTING

- Wisconsin Drivers License*
- Wisconsin State ID*
- Passport*
- Military ID*
 - May be used if expired after the date of the last general election (11/2/10)
- Certificate of Naturalization issued less than 2 years prior to the election
- Receipt for Drivers License issued less than 60 days prior to the election
- ID issued by a federally recognized Indian Tribe in WI
- College or university student ID that includes
 - Date of Issuance
 - Signature of Student
 - Expiration date no later than 2 years after issuance
 - Accompanied with proof of enrollment

ELECTION DAY REGISTRATION

- Must provide number of WI Drivers License or State ID if you have one**
- Residency—One of the following required**
- WI Drivers License or State ID with current address
- Any ID card or license issued by a WI government agency
- Lease, property tax bill for current year
- Utility bill sent within last 90 days
- Affidavit on public or private social service agency letterhead
- Bank statement
- Pay stub

OBTAINING A STATE ID

- One in each category is required:
- Legal presence**
 - Certified birth certificate
 - Certificate of citizenship
 - Valid passport
 - TSA workers ID
- Identity**
 - Social Security Card
 - Marriage certificate
 - Divorce certificate
 - Out of state drivers license or state ID
 - TSA workers ID
 - Military discharge papers
 - Military dependent card
 - Legal Guardian ID card
- WI Residency**
 - Pay Stub
 - Mortgage or Lease documents
 - Utility bill
 - Employee Photo ID
 - Bank Statement
 - Certified School Record
 - Government issued correspondence

OBTAINING A BIRTH CERTIFICATE

- For a WI birth certificate, just fill out a form and mail in.
 - No documents needed.
 - Cost is \$20.
 - Time to obtain is two weeks.
- In person, you must show valid state-issued ID with current address
- Requirements vary in other states. Refer to the Department of Vital Records in that state. 34 states require a copy of your state-issued photo ID or passport. Time to receive birth certificates—up to 6 months. Costs vary.
